
As we discussed on April 13, 2010, we disagree with the characterization in Attorney Tierney's letter of the same date. His office and Town counsel appear to have reached some type of agreement. My office and the intervenors whom I represent were not involved and intend to object. We were not involved in selecting the April 27, 2010 hearing date. Also, I informed Attorney Tierney last week that I was not available on April 27, 2010 and that he was not in a position to decide who from my office should attend.

Although I appreciate that Judge Mangones is scheduled to retire, I do not agree with the manner in which opposing counsel is proceeding. I am unavailable most of the last week of April due to pre-existing vacation plans. Typically, New Hampshire attorneys work through these issues and avoid involving the courts. Regrettably, that did not occur in this case.

If we cannot appear before Judge Mangones prior to his retirement, then this case should fall to his replacement. I am available to discuss scheduling of this matter.
